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Beskrivelse

Børn helt ned til en alder af syv år bruges til at sælge og transportere stoffer overalt i Storbritannien. Her følger vi nogle af de mindreårige narkokurerer, der er fanget i det farlige miljø. Og vi møder politi, forældre og socialarbejdere, der prøver at beskytte de unge og holde dem i sikkerhed, før det er for sent.

Pædagogisk note

Udsendelsen kan muliggøre, at eleverne får indblik i forskellige perspektiver på problematikken med, at børn bliver en del af det kriminelle miljø og med de såkaldte 'county lines'. Den kan bruges til, at eleverne først skal forstå og beskrive de perspektiver, som kommer frem; evt. fokusere på 'Jacob' og eller de andre unge, måske lave en struktureret mundtlig deling i grupper, og dernæst samtaler om dette aspekt af kultur- og samfund i Storbritannien. Måske kan der laves en sammenligning med danske forhold. Kapitelsættet kan hjælpe gå i dybden med bestemte nedslag ifm. udsendelsen.
